Course methodology/Instructional Strategies	This course combines presentations with video applications. Selected topics will be explored in depth through a combination of formal discussions (both in-class and online), hands-on activities and assignments. Instructional strategies include lecture, demonstration, discussion, practical applicationand presentations. The training approach of the course consists of: Lectures – instruction and theory on the subject matter. Small group exercises – adapting theory. Case studies – use of scenarios to exercise problem solving.
