# Further courses

- Problem Based Learning (PBL)
- Master thesis supervision

# Regular seminars

- Aimed at more experienced teaching staff
- Some recent examples include:
  - *Working with critical thinking in teaching*
  - *Active learning with response systems*
  - *Sustainable development*
  - *Active learning in larger student groups*

# On demand workshops

- Offered to groups of HE teachers (e.g. a division or a program) where we visit the group on their terms
- Some examples:
  - *Learning for sustainable development*
  - *How to write a course plan and formulate learning outcomes*
  - *Starting to supervise degree projects*
  - *Maintaining a pedagogical portfolio*
  - *Developing as a teacher through peer visits*
  - *The role of e-learning at a campus based university*
  - *Recording lectures*

# Yearly conference

- Two days with the same program repeated for our two main campuses
- Typical program
  - Invited speaker
  - Teaching staff can present development work and discuss new ideas
  - Groups that have received special grants for pedagogical development will present their work

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
