COURSE TITLE: Effective online teaching techniques

DATE AND TIME: SEPTEMBER 8, 1:00PM, 3:00PM (CET/Brussels time)

For the 1.00 PM course about 100 participants were registered, and for the 3.00 PM course around 60 participants were registered. Surprisingly, few participants entered the training session. 15 participants for the first session and 9 for the second one. Because participants in the second session were few, I was not able to conduct group work.

In general, the sessions went well. Participants learned some and digital and communicative tools, which they can use in their online teaching practices. TRICIDER was presented as an online brainstorming tool, which engages students in active discussion. Participants practiced the Gallery walk method as an active, participatory approach for online classes. Jamboard was used as a digital tool during the Gallery walk.

Participants also were informed on some small techniques, which they can use to engage more students.
