# STEP 2: ON SCREEN PPT

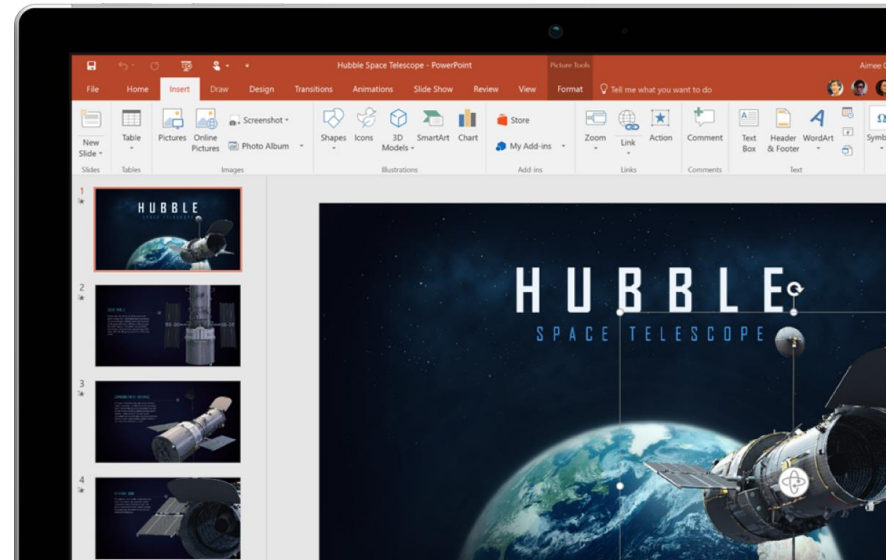


- **CREATE** a PPT that will illustrate your talk:
